BEFORE YOU START

NOTES TO CONSIDER:

SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

- This pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.
- Place a marker (I like to use a piece of yarn of a different color) at the end of every finished round
- At the end of each round, the number of total stitches for that round is in parentheses ()
- Brackets [] indicate a pattern sequence
- When making amigurumi, you'll want to use a smaller hook than called for on your yarn information.

Try different sizes until you get a nice tight finish

- The yarn I used in this pattern is worsted weight, and the hook is 3.25mm, this results in a finished doll of approximately 6 inches (15 cms). You can vary the size of the doll by using thicker or thinner yarn, different size hooks or even double or triple yarn. Be creative!

- After completing each step, cut the yarn and hide remaining tails inside the doll, unless otherwise stated (for instance, we'll use some of these tails to sew different parts to the body of the doll). This is described as FO (fasten off).

- Fill the doll with stuffing as you go. In the pattern I indicate when I suggest you start filling, please keep in mind you will probably need more stuffing than you think. The firmer you stuff, the better shaped your doll will turn out.

- At the end of this page, you will find several links to videos with some of the techniques used. Keep in mind, even though this pattern is beginner level, you need some crochet knowledge foundation.

- This pattern is written in US crochet terminology for right-handed crocheting.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg- begin(ning)

mr - magic ring

ch- chain

st - stitch

sc - single crochet

sl st - slip stitch

inc - increase (work 2 sc in the next st)

dec - decrease (2 sc together or invisible decrease)

blo - back loop only

FO - fasten off or finish off

R - row

MATERIALS:

worsted weight yarn in black

worsted weight yarn in purple

stuffing

3.5mm hook

safety craft cat eyes 12mm

tapestry needle

scissors

tiny heart button

PATTERN

This cat will be worked from the bottom up

BODY

- R1 Magic ring 6 (6)
R2 [2 sc in each st] 6 times (12)
R3 [sc in next st, 2 sc in next st] 6 times (18)
R4 [sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times (24)
R5 BLO sc in each st around (24)
R6 sc in each st around (24)
R7 [sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st] 6 times (30)
R8 - 9 sc in each st around (30)
R10 dec, sc in each st around (28)
R11 dec, sc in each st around (26)
R12 dec, sc in each st around (24)
R13 dec, sc in each st around (22)
R14 dec, sc in each st around (20)
R15 dec, sc in each st around (18)
R16 dec, sc in each st around (16)
R17 dec, sc in each st around (14)
R18 dec, sc in each st around (12)
Start filling and continue filling as you go
R19 dec, sc in each st around (10)
R20 - 21 sc in each st around (10)
R22 FLO, [sc in next st, 2 sc in next] 5 times (15)
R23 [sc in next 2 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 times (20)
R24 [sc in next 3 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 times (25)
R25 [sc in next 4 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 times (30)
R26 [sc in next 5 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 times (35)
R27 - 34 sc in each st around (35)
R35 hdc in next 3 st, dc, hdc in next 3 st, sc in next 10 st, hdc in next 3 st, dc, hdc in next 3 st
attach the eyes between rows 29-30, 7 st apart. Remember eye placement is personal and can dramatically affect the look of your amigurumi, so make sure to try different placement spots to make sure you like them



PATTERN



COLLAR

- R1 ch18
R2 Starting on 2nd ch from hook, work a sc in each st.
R3 ch 1, turn and work a sc in each.
sew the heart button on the middle of the collar, then sew it on the kitten's neck.

TAIL

- R1 mr 6
R2 - 24 sc in each st around (6)
FO and leave long tail for sewing to the body
use a dark pipe cleaner to help give shape
sew it to the body
